INCREASE IN MAXIMUM NUMBER OF RUNNERS PER TRAINER IN A RACE

As you are aware, there is currently a limitation on the number of runners which a Trainer can run in non-group races (maximum two (2)). In this regard, the current structure provides that a Trainer is entitled to one runner per race unless there is remaining capacity in a race in which case, he is allowed a maximum of one further runner.

However, in view of the prevailing conditions in horseracing in Mauritius, the current structure is amended as follows:

In any field, a Trainer shall be entitled to one runner per race unless the capacity of the field has not been reached, in which case, a Trainer can declare a second runner in a race. However, if there is still a remaining capacity in a race, a Trainer shall be entitled to declare a third runner in such race. Each of the above shall be subject to normal balloting processes and the racing guidelines.

The above change shall take effect immediately.
